Internship

Freed Hardeman University, Henderson, TN

Mr. Muller experienced show prep, news prep, board operations duties, production, copy writing, and general on air duties. The student completed his internship on August 19, 2008. No credit hours were given for the internship.

University of Tennessee, Martin, TN

Beginning April 12, 2008 student J. Endicott from University of Tennessee at Martin, TN entered our internship schedule with the programming department. Ms. Endicott learned copy writing, production, show prep, and was allowed to produce on-air commercials. Ms. Endicott completed her internship on August 8, 2008. No credit hours were given for the internship.

Lane College, Jackson, TN

Lane College students receive three (3) credit hours. Michael Dennis, is the Professor and Chair of Mass Communications for Lane College.

Career Fairs

The job fair was located at Scotts Hill High School on April 2nd, from 8:30 am until 10:30am. The classes rotated four times during the two hour period. Nikki Yarbro, Promotion Director, represented Forever Communications and spoke with each class explaining the opportunities associated with careers in radio. Students were given Forever Communications employment brochures along with the opportunity fill out applications and submit resumes.

Mike covered getting set up the Listener Club and the specifics of how to maintain an ongoing campaign of email blasts and pertinent Listener Club emails/newsletters with the members of our station email lists.

On November 21, 2008 Verla Price, General Manager and Betty Eggenberger, Executive Assistant, attended a two hour seminar at the Jackson Chamber of Commerce, Jackson, TN. The event was hosted by the Law Offices of Baker, Donelson, Bearman, & Berkowitz, Memphis, TN. The presentation included recent changes to the FMLA and the ADA; Employee Free Choice Act.

On January, 27, 2008 Verla Price, Executive Vice President met with Scott Bradford, Marketing Services Employer Service Specialist with the State of Tennessee Department of Labor & Workforce Development. Mr. Bradford

covered the new changes in Tennessee Labor Laws and offered information available to employers to assist in job recruitment, and training. In addition Mr. Bradford offered insight to Occupational Safety & Health Compliance Services as well as educational and training seminars available for employees and employers. Ms. Price was given material with web links to services offered by the State of Tennessee.
